How to Reset DX940e to Factory Default

Only time you will need to reset the switch to factory default.

- 1. If you have forgotten password of DX940e, or
- 2. you want to re-configure the device again.

To reset the device to factory default, you will need CLI (Command Line Interface) access using console port (9-pin DB9 connector) on the device. You will also need Serial Communication application like Tera Term or Putty.

Pre-requisites:

- 1. Access to device
- 2. Null Modem serial cable (USB to DB9 connector cable)
- 3. Serial Communication Software for example Tera Term, or Putty


Connect DX940e with a serial null modem cable (USB to DB9 connector cable) on the console port of the device, and USB port on your Laptop. Open a serial communication application like Term Term or Putty to get the CLI (Command Line Interface) access to the device. Set the COM Port Setting for Serial Port:

Baud Rate: 38400, Data: 8bits, Parity: none, Stop bits: 1 bit, Flow Control: none

Power cycle the device, once it's start booting, you will see a message

###Hold down SPACE key to stop boot process ###

Note: Press the "SPACE BAR" on your laptop or PC, or keep tapping the "SPACE BAR" key, till you see the sentence **Starting boot menu...**



Type "9" at the prompt, and press Enter Key to Restore System to Factory Defaults. You will see the warning message as shown in screen below:

Select "yes" Are you sure you want to continue. This will erase the configuration file, and leave the switch with factory default and firmware. See screen below:
