

5/10RX SNTP Configuration

SNTP (Simple Network Time Protocol) is a feature that allows for the configuration of time synchronization to a time server. Setting up a remote time synchronization means that all time related or time sensitive functions in the local 5/10RX will be “synchronized” with all other systems in the network that also use the same synchronization servers. This is very useful for diagnostics of log files.
